THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CHARLESTOWN WAS HELD ON MONDAY, MAY 1, 2023, AT 6:30 PM WITH MAYOR TREVA HODGES PRESIDING.

Agenda

Councilwoman Jackson made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilman Cox. Approved 3-0.

Minutes, Claims and PR Voucher

Public Comments

Dana Cook from Loves Endeavor spoke about details and funding for the Safe Haven “baby box” to be installed at the Charlestown Volunteer Fire Department.

Mayor’s Comments

Mayor Hodges mentioned that bids for current projects have been published. The bids for the Family Activities Park will be opened on 5/17/23 and the Wastewater Treatment Plant bids will be opened on 6/15/23.

Council Comments

Councilwoman Jackson mentioned that the reason for Councilman Hester’s absenteeism was due to a baseball game. They currently rank 7th in the state.

Ordinance 2023-OR-06

This Ordinance amends the text of the Charlestown Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Control Ordinance to establish the Industrial – River Ridge (IR) District with use, development, and administrative standards, with associated amendments to the Zone Map to rezone property to the IR District.

Greg Fifer spoke on behalf of the River Ridge Development Authority regarding the ordinance. He explained that the zoning area was left off of the 2016 revised city zoning ordinance and recent land sales necessitated it be updated and included in the city zoning.

Councilwoman Jackson motioned to approve Ordinance 2023-OR-06, seconded by Councilman Cox. Approved 4-0.

Councilman Cox made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Councilman Steele. Approved 4-0.
