ORDINANCE NO. 1997-5

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS LAND
(CHARLESTOWN MIDDLE SCHOOL)

WHEREAS, the boundary of the City of Charlestown, Indiana, is adjacent to the real estate described herein; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the real estate described herein has requested that said real estate be annexed into the City of Charlestown; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City to annex the real estate described herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council for the City of Charlestown, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. The following described real estate shall be, and the same is hereby, annexed to and declared to be a part of the City of Charlestown, Clark County, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of Survey No. 95 of the Illinois Grant in Charlestown Township of Clark County, Indiana, being a part of the same 100.13 acre of tract conveyed to James H. Todd at Deed Record 128, page 260 and bounded as follows:

Beginning at a stone which marks the north corner of said Survey No. 95 of the Illinois Grant, thence the following courses of the boundary:

South 35 deg. 43 min. 20 sec. East. 1248.95 feet (380.679 meters) with the line dividing Surveys No. 95 and 96 of the Illinois Grant to a stone: South 53 deg. 32 min. 40 sec. West, 695.11 feet (211.869 meters), severing the land of the grantor to an iron pin; North 35 deg. 43 min. 20 sec. West, 1242.94 feet (378.848 meters), severing the land of the grantor to an iron pin buried one foot deep: North 35 deg. 43 min. 20 sec. West, 15.00 feet (4.572 meters), continuing with last said course to an iron spike in the southerly side of the High Jackson Road and in the line dividing Surveys No. 95 and 116 of the Illinois Grant; North 54 deg. 17 min. 00 sec. East, 295.05 feet (89.931 meters) with last said dividing line to an iron pin; North 54 deg. 17 min. 00 sec. East, 400.00 feet (121.920 meters) continuing with last said dividing line to the place of beginning and containing 20.000 acres (8.093 hectares) of land,

which said property is commonly known as Charlestown Middle School.

Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Charlestown, Clark County, Indiana, shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be extended so as include all the real estate herein above described in Section 1, as part of the municipality of the City of Charlestown, Indiana.

Section 3. The annexed territory described herein shall be assigned to City Council District No. 4.

Section 4. The Clerk-Treasurer, pursuant to I.C. 36-4-3-22, shall file a copy of this ordinance with the Recorder of Clark County, Indiana, within ninety (90) days of the effective date herein.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of Indiana.
